


DONATISTS (A.D. 311)

Biblical

- Against Constantinianism
- Based on personal faith and is not inclusive of all in a given locality
- Baptism by immersion of believers only

Errors

- Pastors would say, "the acre of the Lord continues in Africa alone"
- Legalistic morals
- Ascetic
- Ex opera operantis

PAULICIANS (~A.D. 600)

Biblical

- Against Constantinianism
- Based on personal faith and is not inclusive of all in a given locality
- Evangelistic
- Baptism by immersion of believers only
 - Called Sabians (Arabic word for Baptists)

Errors

- Dualistic
- Denied the humanity of Christ
- Rejected Christ's cross
- Marcionic

PETROBRUSIANS (~A.D. 1100)

Biblical

- Against Constantinianism
- Scripture and not tradition from those who attempt to refute him
- "We wait until the proper time has come, after a man is ready to know his God and believe in Him; we do not, as they accuse us, rebaptize him who may be said never to have been baptized before"
- Evangelistic
- Baptism by immersion of believers only

Errors

• Incited monks to marry

WALDENSIANS (~A.D. 1170)

Biblical

- Against Constantinianism
- Translated and circulated the Bible
- Based on personal faith and is not inclusive of all in a given locality
- Evangelistic
- Baptism by immersion of believers only

Errors

Inconsistent

ALBIGENSES (~A.D. 1190)

Biblical

- Against Constantinianism
- Benefits of society belong to all members of it
- The law of Moses was no rule for Christians
- Based on personal faith and is not inclusive of all in a given locality
- Baptism by immersion of believers only
- Evangelistic

Errors

- Dualistic
- Denied the humanity of Christ
- Denounced all material possessions
- Abstained from meat, milk, cheese, eggs, and sexual relations
- Even suicide was at times practiced to rid the soul of the evil body

- Sigan-Fu (8th century) Missionary to China

- Bernard of Clairvaux (1090-1153) Mystic
