An Introduction to Voluntarism and Compatibilism

## The Apparent Problem

The Bible calls man to choose and says that God chooses

"I do not believe that [unconditional election] can be defended from Scripture. God has given each and every person an ability to choose life and death (Dt 30:19)."

I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live.

And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to it! How often would I have gathered your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you were not willing!

For if I do this of my own will, I have a reward, but if not of my own will, I am still entrusted with a stewardship.

I preferred to do nothing without your consent in order that your goodness might not be by compulsion but of your own accord.

Shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly, as God would have you; not for shameful gain, but eagerly

## God's Sovereignty

The reality of God ruling over His creation, including the wills of His creatures

Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?

Our God is in the heavens; he does all that he pleases.

In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will

### Voluntarism

The desires of man's heart are accountable to God

### Voluntarism

- Man is morally responsible
- "ought" is not conditioned on "able"
- Guilt is attributed to intentions and desires
- We are accountable on the basis of our wanting, not on the basis of our ability or options

### Effects of the Fall

God's Holiness meets Man's Sinfulness

#### Historic Views of the Fall

#### Pelagian:

- Man is spiritually unaffected (no corrupted nature)
- Adam is simply a bad example

#### Semi-Pelagian:

- Man is spiritually wounded, but not dead
- Adam's sin is a hereditary disease

#### **Arminian:**

- Man is spiritually corrupted, but neutralized by Christ's atonement
- Adam corrupted himself and all his posterity

#### **Augustinian:**

Man is spiritually dead

#### Effects of the Fall

- Corruption human nature is polluted by sin, being rendered spiritual dead and incapable of change, involving the whole person in extent and the whole human race in scope
- Guilt personally inherited a sinful status before God
- Punishment liable to the just consequences of sin

### Man's Corruption

- 1. The Natural Mind is Fallen (Ps 94:11)
- 2. The Natural Mind is Futile (Eph 4:17)
- 3. The Natural Mind is **Deceitful** (Jer 17:9)
- 4. The Natural Mind is **Debased** (Rom 1:28)
- 5. The Natural Mind is **Darkened** (Eph 4:18)
- 6. The Natural Mind is **Hostile** (Col 1:21)
- 7. The Natural Mind is Incurably Sick (Jer 17:9)
- 8. The Natural Mind is **Dead** (Eph 2:1)

For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot.



#### Fatalism

- Human choice is illusory
- Incompatible with human choice
- Man has no choice
- Hard-determinism

#### Libertarian Free Will

- Ability to do something or not
- Incompatible with determinism
- Man's choices override God's
- Indeterminism

### \*Voluntarism (Free Agency)

- Ability to do what you want
- Compatible with determinism
- Man's choices cooperate with God's
- Soft-determinism

## Consecrate yourselves, therefore, and be holy, for I am the LORD your God.

### Biblical Principles Concerning Free Will

- 1) The Bible never declares man to be free in an absolute sense
  - The choices of man are not free from causality
  - "The heart of man plans his way, but the LORD establishes his steps" (Proverbs 16:9)
  - "He turned their hearts to hate his people, to deal craftily with his servants" (Psalm 105:25)
- 2) God is specifically sovereign (Ps 115:3; 135:6; Rom 8:28; Eph 1:11)
- 3) God is omniscient (knows future events)

### Biblical Principles Concerning Free Will

- 4) God foreordains ends (predetermines certain outcomes)
- 5) People do not have libertarian free will in heaven
- 6) God does not have a libertarian free will
